

If PASNAP Shows Up at Your Door Uninvited, You Can Tell Them to Go Away.

Representatives from the Pennsylvania Association of Staff Nurses and Allied Professionals may show up unannounced at the homes of employees. This is another tactic the union likes to use to catch you off-guard in hopes of selling themselves as something you need in your work life.

You need to know that Penn Medicine at Home (PMAH) did not provide the union with any of your personal information. PMAH does not believe a union is in your best interest here, and we feel you should not be bothered at home by a union. So, we have no reason to give them your address.

If you don't want to talk to the union at your home, you can just tell them to go away. You are under no obligation to talk to them at any time.
