

Have You Changed Your Mind About PASNAP?

If you have changed your mind about previously signing a union authorization card, you can revoke your authorization.

It doesn't matter if you feel you were not given accurate information, were misled about signing a card or using an electronic signature, or simply decided a union is not right for you, you have a legal right to request your card be returned or signature deleted.

Mail a letter or send an email to PASNAP
(be sure to keep a copy for your records)

I wasn't aware the union would share my name, address and phone number with other people after signed.

Consider the points below...

- Changed your mind
- Didn't have all the facts
- Have reconsidered after learning more
- Didn't know signing gave the union the right to represent me
- Please return my card to address below
- Please delete my information from your outreach efforts

The union rep made a lot of promises that I now know cannot be guaranteed.
